They are:

Social—Spiritual Development

- Developing a positive self-esteem
- Practicing self-control
- Developing a positive relationship with peers and adults
- Helping other and learning to compromise
- Making decisions and showing initiative
- Appreciating and celebrating diversity
- Engaging in various levels of play

Communication Arts

- Listening to others and sharing information during group discussion
- Developing speaking, listening, and writing skills

Expressive Arts

- Furthering self-expression and communication skills through individual and group activities
- Use of building materials for expression

Wellness

- Working with large muscle groups to further development of upper and lower body skills
- Refining the development of fine motor skills
- Engaging in vigorous indoor/outdoor play.

Discovery

- Furthering knowledge of critical thinking and problem solving
- Furthering knowledge of math concepts through investigation and use of manipulatives
- Hypothesizing, predicting, and testing scientific concepts
- Demonstrating knowledge through dramatic and block play
- Learning about the world through hands-on sensory experiences.
