



Children's Choir

(formerly *Primary Choir*)

All children in grades 1-4 participate in the Children's Choir, which rehearses as a part of their regular music curriculum during class time. The Children's Choir sings in church on Sunday three times a year; additionally, as a part of the school Christmas Service, and at the 8th Grade Graduation. Students learn basic and intermediate levels of music theory, including note reading, rhythm, solfeggi, Orff instruments, and in third and fourth grade, recorder.

Beginning in January, all students in these grades rehearse and participate in the Spring Musical. Practices occur during class time, and feature the fourth grade students, with additional chorus and smaller roles assigned to other grades. There are two mandatory performances in March - one on a Friday during VIP Day, and the second during service the following Sunday.
