"Eagles Bucks" is a form of currency to be used for T.R.I.P. It is a 1:1 ratio dollar amount. In other words, you would purchase \$25 worth of Eagles Bucks with \$25 American dollars or a check for that amount. It works like a T.R.I.P gift certificate

How and Why are Eagles Bucks useful?

It was suggested by a teacher based on another school's model. Families may use Eagles Bucks during a normal gift giving time as a general gift certificate. The teacher redeems collective Eagles Bucks like credit to purchase any specific gift card offered by T.R.I.P. vendors. It benefits teachers because instead of receiving several small unrelated gifts, they may receive one large general gift certificate to be used as they desire.

Not only do teachers benefit, but the T.R.I.P. program is used so that benefits both the A.H. Miller scholarship fund and the school in general as T.R.I.P. provides financial support for both.
